## **I. Mobility Duration Options:**

- 5 months for students intending to attend courses and receive academic recognition for one or more subjects.
- 2 months for students focusing on thesis work, research, or short-term study.

## II. Financial Support:

- The University of Palermo provides incoming students within the MARE project with a monthly scholarship of €900.
- Travel expenses are reimbursed based on ticket costs, up to a maximum of  $\in 309$ .

## **III. Required Documents:**

- CV (maximum 2 pages).
- Copy of National ID card.
- Copy of Passport.
- Letter of Motivation.
- Transcript of records of previous academic studies.
- Certificate of Enrollment in your current program at Alexandria University.
- Bachelor's degree certificate (only for postgraduate applicants).
- For students intending to work on their thesis: Certificate that their proposal has been approved and the approval of their main supervisor.
